Sub: Engagement of Guest Faculties afresh in different Government Colleges for the year 2022-23 & 2023-24

Madam/Sir,

As per this Department letter No.16200 dated 20.4.2022, the tenure of Guest Faculties engaged in Government Degree Colleges of the State will end on 31.8.2022. Thereafter, Guest Faculties will be selected afresh for a tenure of two years starting from 01.9.2022 to 31.8.2024 on the terms and conditions as laid down below.

1. Number of Guest faculties to be engaged:

a. Maximum number of Guest Faculties to be engaged in a subject shall not be more than the total number of existing vacancies vis-a-vis the sanctioned posts in that subject.

b. For subjects having student enrolment but without any sanctioned teaching post, Guest Faculties are to be engaged in the teacher pupil ratio of 1: 25 for UG and 1: 15 for PG students enrolled.

c. One extra Guest Faculty is permissible in the subject of the Principal of the College, as Principals, due to their multifarious administrative work, fail to take classes in their subject. However, a Principal can take class if he/shc so wants.

2. Preference and Procedures for Selection of Guest Faculties:

a. Retired Government College teachers of the same college having not completed 65 years of age, if their pre- retirement performance was up to mark. In the circumstances where availability of such retired teachers exceeds the requirement, the Principal will select the most suitable one.

b. Fresh selection by advertisement in at least one major Odia daily newspaper in the event of non- availability of retired Government College teachers of the same College. In such cases, selection shall be made in the following order of preference.

 Retired teachers of other Government Colleges having not completed 65 years of age. If availability of such retired teachers exceeds the requirement, the Principal will select the most suitable one.

Retired teachers of Aided Colleges having not completed 65 years of age and who
were in receipt of GIA from Government. If availability of such retired teachers
exceeds the requirement, the Principal will select the most suitable one.

Master's Degree in the concerned subject from a recognized University with at least 55% marks or its equivalent grade with a second class in the Bachelor's Degree is essential.
